Recently, she was nominated to be regional advisory board member and co-chair for the British Medical Journal (BMJ) for Asia and the Pacific.

Dr Mercado has served in different senior level positions in the Philippine Government as:

- Co-Chair of the National Panel of Technical Experts, Climate Change Commission
- Board Member, Expert Panel of the Philippine Health Insurance Corporation
- Undersecretary and Chief of Staff, Department of Health

She has received numerous awards including Distinguished Alumni in Global Health by the University of the Philippines in 2017. In 2018, she was recognized as one of the 100 most influential Filipina women in world in the category of Innovator and Thought Leader by the US-based Filipina Women's Network

Dr Mercado has degrees of A.B. Philosophy with a second major in psychology *(magna cum laude)*, Doctor of Medicine and Master of Public Health from the University of the Philippines.

If elected, Dr. Mercado, will be the first woman WPRO Director-General and commits to dedicate her technical and management skills to help the organization address its current operational challenges and make it more efficient and dynamic. Her remarkable acts of multilateral public service and profound impact on the lives of others make her an ideal candidate.
